REALITY CHECK

Reality Check is a student led, adult supported program for those between the ages of 13 through 18. The statewide program is the youth action component of the New York State Bureau of Tobacco Control Program. RC youth work to educate their peers, legislators, community members and key decision makers on the tobacco industry's manipulative marketing practices and how they target youth to become replacement smokers.

TOBACCO'S TOLL IN NYC:



- Over 21,000 public high school students currently smoke.
- One-third of current student smokers will die prematurely.
- Most adult smokers admit to initiating smoking before age 18.
